Colomer \& Sons offers this guide to help you determine your wrist size, allowing you to find the right measurement for adjusting the steel bracelet.
We will resize the bracelet at no extra cost, ensuring you can wear your watch and start enjoying it as soon as possible.

## INSTRUCTIONS FOR CORRECTLY MEASURING THE STEEL BRACELET

## 1. PRINT THIS DOCUMENT AT 100\% SCALE

By doing so, the centimeters on the ruler will be faithfully represented on the printed page. Ensure not to select "fit" in the printing options, as this would distort the actual centimeter measurements.

## 2. CUT THE RULER ALONG THE DOTTED LINE



## 3. MEASURE YOUR WRIST

Place the rounded part of the ruler at the top of your wrist where you would wear the watch. Wrap the ruler completely around your wrist and measure up to the orange line.

IMPORTANT: When measuring your wrist, ensure there's a bit of space for comfort. Colomer \& Sons advises leaving enough room to slip your pinky finger between the strap and your wrist.


## 4. TAKE NOTE OF THE MEASUREMENT

Write down the measurement in centimeters up to the orange line. Use this number to select the closest option in the "ADJUST SIZE" dropdown menu.

ATTENTION: Colomer \& Sons will adjust the size according to the provided measurement. No additional slack will be added.
